Ageing Nepal initiated the first literacy programme for older Nepalis particularly older women.

Outcomes and impacts

Received a grant from the NGO Committee on Ageing, NY and partnered with a US based professor to create the first age appropriate materials in the local language. The first class was such a success that it found government and private support to extend it to other parts of the country. Mr. Gautam received a special UNESCO award for this work.
